## PENALTIES FOR NONCOMPLIANCE

O.C.G.A 48-5-492, 48-5-493

Any person who fails to attach and display a mobile home decal (location permit) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. If convicted, a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$300 shall be imposed, failure to display the decal is a misdemeanor and could result in a fine of \$100.

# **ATTENTION ~ MOVERS/TRANSPORTERS**

O.C.G.A 48-5-493 ~ Any person moving or transporting any manufactured home without the required relocation and location permits shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than \$1000 or imprisonment for not more than 12 months or both.

# **ATTENTION ~ INSTALLERS**

O.C.G.A 8-2-164 ~ An Installation Permit shall be attached by a Licensed Installer to the panel box of each Manufactured Home upon the completion of installation.

#### **General Information**

- Information regarding lot size/set back requirements and other local ordinances can be accessed at www.stephenscountyga.gov or the Building Inspectors Office.
- Only HUD Code or DCA approved Manufactured Homes (built after June 15, 1976) will be permitted to be located in the County.

# **Sanitary Permits ~ Septic Tank Permit**

• Approval of the Wastewater Hookup is obtained from the Stephens County Environmental Health Department. Located in the Health Department at 64 Boulevard Ste 102 Toccoa, GA 706-282-4507 ext. 121.

# **Building Permits**

- Any previously owned Manufactured Home planning to be relocated from **outside** the county **or within** the county will be subject to a code compliance inspection before it is relocated by the County Building Inspector or an approved third party inspector.
- Approval of the site where the Manufactured Home will be located is obtained by application for and the issuance of a Building Permit for the site.
- Building Permits are available in the office of the Building Inspector located in the Stephens County Courthouse Annex at 802 E Doyle St. Toccoa, GA 706-886-9491 ext. 9302 or online at stephenscountyga.gov.

#### **Relocation Permits**

Relocation Permits will NOT be issued until the Sanitary and Building Permits have been issued.

To obtain a Relocation Permit, you must first present the following original documents to the Stephens County Tax Commissioner's Office:

Original Certificate of Title and Title Application for Applicant
(New Homes Require the MSO~ Manufacturer's Statement of Origin)
Bill of Sale including the purchase price
Current Year Tax Paid Receipt for the Manufactured Home
(New Homes require a completed Form PT41 from Sales Retailer)
(Tiew Fromes require a compressed Form F F F From Sures rectainer)
(i.e., romes require a completed rom r r r rom bates rectance)
Other Required Information:

Once these documents are properly submitted, a Relocation Permit will be issued. Permits are valid for 30 days.

# **Final Step ~ Important**

After the Manufactured Home is installed, Approval of the Installation is necessary to obtain a Certificate of Occupancy and permanent electrical service. Installation must Comply with Section 46-35 of the Official Code of Stephens County. Contact the Building Inspections Office to schedule the final inspection.

### Annual Ad Valorem Taxes ~ (Decal/Sticker)

Current Year Location Permits are issued in the Tax Commissioner's office when taxes are paid each year. The Permit is required to be displayed in a prominent location annually on or before April 1st. Penalties for non compliance are listed on the back of this bulletin.
